Together, as partners in the education of our children at Aspley Guise Lower School, we aim to uphold this agreement to develop a happy, stimulating and caring atmosphere within the school and to value each individual irrespective of race, culture and religious belief.

The School will...

Create a culture that values the individuality of each child while setting clear boundaries to help them thrive

- ✓ Facilitate a culture of high expectation and behaviour throughout the school by expecting the best from each child all the time, believing that they can be whatever and whoever they want to be
- ✓ Provide each child with a broad and balanced curriculum that includes teaching of values
- ✓ Set, mark and monitor appropriate regular homework for each child
- ✓ Instil in the pupils the importance of a growth mindset – including understanding that we can learn from both success and failure
- ✓ Encourage children to show care for their surroundings and other people through following the school rules
- ✓ Deal effectively with any incidents of misbehaviour or bullying / cyberbullying
- ✓ Ensure each child is a member of one of its four houses (St. Andrew, St. David, St. George or St. Patrick)

Ensure appropriate and timely communication

- ✓ Regularly provide information on each child's progress
- ✓ Contact parents if there is a problem with a child's work or behaviour, their attendance, punctuality or use of equipment (including e-safety matters)
- ✓ Keep parents/carers informed about school activities through regular newsletters, social media, and our website

As Parents/Carers/Guardians, I/we will...

Support the school's policies on punctuality, attendance and uniform

- ✓ Ensure that my child arrives at school on time, properly equipped and with named belongings
- ✓ Notify the school and provide a note of explanation if my child is absent
- ✓ Ensure my child is wearing full school uniform

Engage and communicate with the school on a regular basis

- ✓ Attend parents evenings and discussions about my child's progress
- ✓ Contact the school with any concerns or problems that may affect my child's work or behaviour

Support and promote the school's culture of Growing Together

- ✓ Adhere to the principles detailed in the Acceptable Use Agreement in the Computing and Online Safety Policy
- ✓ Follow online-safety rules at home
- ✓ Support the school in implementing the Behaviour Policy

Support and promote the school's culture of Aiming High

- ✓ Support my child in homework and other opportunities for home learning
- ✓ Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour
- ✓ Aim to become involved in the life of the school and support school events and functions get to know as much as possible about my child's life at school

In partnership, we will support every child to

- ✓ Aim High! Be the best they can be, irrespective of the achievements of others
- ✓ Engage in tasks (both at home and school) that promote their learning
- ✓ Have the right equipment in school to engage fully in the learning process, including P.E. kit, writing equipment and books
- ✓ Behave well and treat everyone from all backgrounds with respect, whether that be face to face or in the online world
- ✓ Treat the environment and possessions with respect
- ✓ Understand that a problem shared is a problem halved, and that there are people at school who are happy to listen if there is something on their mind
