SCHOOL UNIFORM

We are a uniformed school; our colours are red, white and charcoal grey. The clothing itemised below is that which is permitted under our Uniform Policy.

All items of school uniform bearing the school logo may be purchased from the school or via [Price and Buckland](#). Other items of school uniform can be purchased from High Street stores, adhering to the items below.

Cold weather:

- tailored charcoal grey trousers
- tailored charcoal grey skirt or pinafore dress
- **school** white or cherry red polo shirt
- plain white or cherry red polo shirt or plain white long-sleeved shirt
- **school** sweatshirt
- **school** cardigan
- grey or white socks
- red or grey tights

Warmer weather:

In addition to the above:

- red and white checked dress with white socks
- tailored charcoal grey shorts
- white short-sleeved shirt

Footwear – We do not allow open toed or sling back sandals or canvas shoes for reasons of health and safety. Sensible black or red shoes must be worn.

Games and PE activities

Children must wear:

- ✓ Black shorts
- ✓ A house colour (St. Andrew- blue, St. David- Yellow, St. George- red and St. Patrick- Green) **school** logo T-shirt
- ✓ Black plimsolls or Velcro trainers. Training shoes are allowed for PE providing the children can put them on independently.
- ✓ Black tracksuit bottoms can also be worn for outdoor PE in colder weather.

Children must also have:

- ✓ A **school** book bag
- ✓ A **school** PE bag
- ✓ A **school** water bottle
- ✓ Their house badge

all of which are all available to purchase via school money/the school office.

For outdoor wear **school** caps/hats and **school** fleeces/outdoor coats are available.

If for religious reasons you are unable to abide by our uniform policy please discuss this with the Headteacher.

Please ensure that all clothes worn to school are clearly marked with your child's name.

WATCHES AND JEWELLERY

No jewellery should be worn to school. No earrings are to be worn. Only a plain named watch may be worn, but this must be removed for sports activities.

A second-hand uniform scheme operates at the school. Please ask at the office for details.
